At any time, you may talk to a social worker at the Social Services Gateway Team on 0300 1234 333 or the Regional Emergency Social Work Service on 02895 049999 – 5pm-9am Monday to Thursday, 5pm to 9am Friday to Monday. 24 hour cover over public holidays and 365 days per year. Our designated Governor for Child Protection and Safeguarding is Mr R Hall.
